COVID-19: Phased move to Alert Level 1

COVID-19: Keep alert and stay compliant

Gwynedd Council's Public Protection team continue to visit businesses to provide advice and ensure the regulations are followed. Crucial feedback for both retail and hospitality is the importance of making sure staff are wearing face masks at all times.

In addition, for hospitality, it is vitally important that contact tracing details are fully collected. Every hospitality business – including pubs, bars, cafés and restaurants – is required to collect the details (name, telephone number and a record of the date and arrival time of everyone over 18) for all staff, customers

and visitors and keep this information in a safe place for 21 days. Displaying a NHS App QR code on its own doesn't comply with the rules.

The Economic Resilience Fund provides further support to those businesses who have/are/will be directly impacted to a significant degree by the ongoing restrictions in response to COVID-19.

Businesses with a pre-COVID turnover of £85,000+ can apply directly to the Welsh Government before the extended deadline of 5:00pm on 14 June 2021.

Businesses with a pre-COVID turnover of under £85,000 can apply via Gwynedd Council until 5:00pm on 31 June 2021.
