NEWS: Cyngor Gwynedd Arosfan overnight motorhome and campervan pilot scheme

After securing funding through the Welsh Government's Brilliant Basics (May 2022) programme, Cyngor Gwynedd hopes to trial five 'aire'-style overnight sites for motorhomes and campervans, as part of a project to further prevent the environmental and social problems caused by illegal camping. The Arosfan project will be submitting planning applications for sites at Caernarfon, Llanberis, Cricieth, Pwllheli and Barmouth, using established car parks near town centres to encourage local spend.
