### **Time running out for Gwynedd businesses to claim firebreak grant**

Gwynedd Council has issued a press release encouraging businesses in the county to present their applications for Welsh Government financial support to help companies affected by the firebreak lockdown. The Lockdown Non-Domestic Rates Grants and Lockdown Discretionary Grant being administered by Local Authorities will close at 5:00pm this Friday, 20 November 2020, or when the funding is fully committed. When applying, ensuring that all the relevant documents required are provided, and ensuring that the application is filled in correctly will speed up the process.
