# **FUNDING: Circular Economy Fund: WRAP Cymru**

Capital investment to increase recycled content in products manufactured in Wales, or to extend the useful life-time of products, is available from the Circular Economy Fund. Eligible organisations of any size may either apply for a Small Scale grant for projects with total capital costs from £75,000 to £335,000, or a Large Scale grant for projects with total capital costs in excess of £335,000, with a maximum grant allowable of £770,000.
