### Alert Level 4 restrictions across Wales

From midnight Saturday 19 December 2020, the whole of Wales entered Alert Level 4 restrictions.

- Click and collect services

Unlike in earlier lockdowns, at Level 4 all shops can offer click and collect or similar services, whether or not they are required to close their premises. To reduce the number of journeys people make, all goods and services must be ordered in advance online, by telephone or mail order.

## **Additional support for businesses in response to new restrictions**

The Business Restriction Funds were launched by the Welsh Government in response to the restrictions on hospitality venues, visitor attractions and arts and entertainment venues between 4 and 23 December 2020. As Wales has entered Alert Level 4 restrictions, the support will be extended to businesses directly impacted by the additional restrictions.

Gwynedd Council has already released payments to some hospitality businesses (including hotels, pubs, visitor attractions, restaurants and other eateries) and will release payments to other businesses required to close (including holiday accommodation, non-essential retail and close contact services) as soon as possible, beginning in the week commencing 28 December 2020.

Support will also be available to supply chain businesses and businesses who do not pay Non-domestic Rates. More information available from tomorrow, go to:
