Cultural Recovery Fund 2021-22: Eligibility Checker live

The Welsh Government is launching a further phase of the Cultural Recovery Fund. Support will be available for organisations such as theatres, music venues, recording and rehearsal spaces, heritage attractions, heritage organisations, museums, libraries, galleries, archives, independent cinemas, comedy venues and events to cover the ongoing impact of the pandemic for the period from 1 April 2021 to 30 September 2021.

The Fund will be open for applications from the week beginning 6 April 2021 and close on 20 April 2021, and an eligibility checker is now live, go to:

£1.3m for Welsh seafood sector to help deal with Brexit and Covid impacts

The Welsh Government has launched a new £1.3 million scheme to help the Welsh fishing and aquaculture sector in response to the impact of leaving the EU and the Covid-19 pandemic. The new Welsh Seafood Sector Resilience Scheme will support seafood businesses through two elements. The first part

of the scheme will see a targeted one-off grant made available to eligible Welsh vessel-owning fishing businesses, with the grant equivalent to three months' vessel costs, capped at £10,000. The second part will see support provided to aquaculture businesses, including those trading in live bivalve molluscs. The scheme is open for applications, and will close on 31 March 2021. Rural Business Investment Scheme (Food) is now open

RBIS (Food) covers capital investments costs and supports projects that offer clear and quantifiable benefits to the food and drink industry in Wales. The scheme is open to existing and start up micro & small food and drink processors and manufacturers throughout Wales. The maximum grant rate for any individual investment project is 40% of the total eligible costs. The maximum grant threshold per undertaking for any individual investment project is £150,000, and the minimum is £5,000. Guidance and criteria for the scheme is available at:

Motorhome and Campervan provision – Gwynedd campsite owners survey

Gwynedd Council and Snowdonia National Park Authority are conducting a survey of campsite owners to learn what they know and think about 'wild camping' (people parking and sleeping in their vehicle in car parks, forests, lay-bys, on beaches etc.). Motorhome and Campervan 'Wild camping' has become a topic of discussion in the past few years in Gwynedd, especially in certain areas where local communities and the environment are affected.

The information collected will help improve the management of 'wild camping', and meet the needs of communities, local businesses and visiting leisure vehicle owners. The survey will only take a few moments to complete and campsite owners are asked to take a moment to participate. (A survey of motorhome and campervan owners is also being undertaken).
