Carrying out a coronavirus risk assessment continues to be a legal requirement for all businesses, employers and event organisers and they need to take reasonable measures to minimise the risk of exposure to, and spread of, coronavirus. Particular attention should be paid to:

- Social distancing, particularly in busy areas
- Good ventilation
- Good hand hygiene

There are COVID-19 testing sites, for those with coronavirus symptoms, in Bangor and Caernarfon:

- Bangor
 A COVID-19 testing centre, open from 9:30am to 5:30pm, 7 days a week,
 has been set up in Minafon Car Park, Sackville Road, Bangor LL57 1LA.
- The COVID-19 mobile testing unit in Caernarfon, open 9:30am 4:30pm, 7 days a week. is located at the Shell Site Car Park, Caernarfon LL55 1SQ.
