New targeted restrictions in the hospitality and leisure sectors announced

A set of new targeted restrictions in the hospitality and leisure sectors, has been announced by First Minister Mark Drakeford. From Friday 4 December 2020, pubs, bars, restaurants and cafés will have to close by 6:00pm and will not be allowed to serve alcohol. After 6:00pm they will only be able to provide takeaway services. Indoor entertainment and visitor attractions will be required to close under the new restrictions. For further information on the announcement, go to:
