Dogs are highly intelligent animals that require mental and physical stimulation. It is important for keepers of dogs to consider how the environment in which they are kept is designed to meet their behavioral needs. The Animal Welfare (Breeding of Dogs) (Wales) Regulations 2014 were made, requires that an animal's five primary needs should be met:

- Need for a suitable environment
- Need for a suitable diet
- Need to exhibit normal behavioural patterns
- Need to be housed with, or apart from, other animals
- Need to be protected from pain, suffering, injury or disease

The following points should be considered when planning how to meet your dog's needs. This should not be a one-size-fits-all approach and should be tailored to take into consideration breed, age, health condition etc.:

The intention in this plan is to provide for the licence applicant to detail on how some of the needs above goals will be met.

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Positive interaction with carers• Carers to have a positive relationship with each dog• Dogs not left alone for extended periods of time• Dogs able to interact with other dogs• Varied opportunities to exercise• Kennelled environments should be interesting and comfortable	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Activities that encourage natural behaviour e.g. chewing• Enhancing the sensory environment (sight, smell etc)• Building in predictability to dogs' routine• Regular, positive training activities• Quiet periods• Gradual introduction of dogs to potentially stressful situations
