Main Electoral and Community Activities

- Continue to work in the Community and collaborate with the Local Community Councils to make sure that the community's interests are protected.
- Helping whenever possible in the soup kitchen held for the elderly of the villages of Llanbedr and Llanfair, and also taking the opportunity to have a chat with the residents who attend and listen to their concerns and complaints. These were held fortnightly until they were postponed mid March due to the Covid 19 virus.
- Regularly visit the Primary School in Llanbedr, but at the moment I keep in touch with the Head via e-mail.
- I am still campaigning with Network Rail officers to install barriers on the crossing at Talwrn Bach, Llanbedr.
- The Bypass Plan was granted Planning Permission in March 2020. I am still in contact with the relevant Officers to see what the latest news is with this important plan.
- I attended the ceremony of switching on the Christmas lights in Llanbedr Village, and I was part of a social evening that was held at the end of November.
- I arranged to go litter picking around the Village with some of the local residents.
- I attended Ardudwy's Annual Eisteddfod – I have been Treasurer of the Eisteddfod for many years.
- I attended Ysgol Llanbedr's Christmas Fair and Christmas Show.
- I attended Ysgol Ardudwy's Carol Service.
- Since the beginning of the lockdown period on 23rd March I have been working very closely with the residents of Llanbedr and Llanfair. During the period, I have received many telephone calls, e-mails and messages regarding matters including
 - Second homes
 - Wild camping in the valleys
 - Illegally staying in areas

In this respect, I have been in contact with the Police on many occasions.

During the lockdown period, I have also visited residents (at their request), maintaining social distance of course.
