#### Teulu pâr sy'n cyd-fyw

Bydd teulu pâr sy'n cyd-fyw yn cynnwys dau unigolyn o'r un rhyw sy'n byw gyda'i gilydd fel pâr, gyda neu heb eu plant, ond nad ydynt yn briod nac mewn partneriaeth sifil o'r un rhyw. Gall y plant fod yn perthyn i'r ddau aelod o'r pâr neu un yn unig. Dim ond os nad ydynt hwy eu hunain yn byw gyda phriod, partner sifil o'r un rhyw neu bartner ac nad oes ganddynt blant eu hunain yn yr aelwyd y caiff plant eu cynnwys.

Caiff parau sy'n cyd-fyw gyda'u hwyrion eu hystyried yn deulu pâr sy'n cyd-fyw hefyd os nad oes unrhyw blant o'r genhedlaeth yn y canol yn yr aelwyd (noder y gall plant y pâr hefyd fod yn bresennol os nad ydynt yn rhieni nac yn neiniau a theidiau'r genhedlaeth ieuengaf).

#### Aelwyd pâr sy'n cyd-fyw

Mae aelwyd pâr sy'n cyd-fyw yn aelwyd sy'n cynnwys teulu pâr sy'n cyd-fyw a neb arall. Caiff y diffiniad hwn ei defnyddio yn y rhan fwyaf o ganlyniadau Cyfrifiad 2011.

Mewn nifer fach o ganlyniadau diffinnir aelwyd pâr sy'n cyd-fyw fel aelwyd sy'n cynnwys un pâr sy'n cyd-fyw o leiaf, ond nid yw'n cynnwys unrhyw barau priod na phartneriaethau sifil o'r un rhyw. Lle defnyddir y diffiniad hwn fe'i nodir yn glir.

#### Plentyn dibynnol

Mae plentyn dibynnol yn unigolyn rhwng 0 a 15 oed mewn aelwyd (p'un a yw hynny mewn teulu ai peidio) neu'n unigolyn rhwng 16 a 18 oed mewn addysg amser llawn sy'n byw mewn teulu gyda'i riant neu ei rieni. Nid yw'n cynnwys unrhyw blentyn sydd â phriod, partner neu blentyn yn byw yn yr aelwyd.

#### Teulu

Diffinnir teulu fel grŵp o bobl sydd naill ai yn:

- bâr priod, pâr mewn partneriaeth sifil o'r un rhyw, neu bâr sy'n cyd-fyw, gyda phlentyn/plant neu heb blentyn/plant,
- riant unigol gyda phlentyn/plant
- pâr priod, pâr mewn partneriaeth sifil o'r un rhyw, neu bâr sy'n cyd-fyw gyda'u hwyrion lle nad oes unrhyw blant o'r genhedlaeth yn y canol yn bresennol
- neiniau/teidiau unigol gyda'u hwyrion lle nad oes unrhyw blant o'r genhedlaeth yn y canol yn bresennol

Nid oes angen i blant mewn teuluoedd pâr fod yn perthyn i'r ddau aelod o'r pâr.

O ran neiniau/teidiau unigol neu mewn pâr gydag wrion yn bresennol, gall plant y neiniau/teidiau fod yn bresennol hefyd os nad ydynt yn rhieni neu'n neiniau/teidiau i'r genhedlaeth ieuengaf.

#### Myfyriwr amser llawn

Unigolyn o unrhyw oed sydd wedi nodi ei fod yn blentyn ysgol neu'n fyfyrwr mewn addysg amser llawn yw myfyriwr amser llawn.

Caiff plant ysgol a myfyrwyr mewn addysg llawn amser sy'n astudio oddi cartref eu trin fel pætaent yn preswyllo yn eu cyfeiriad yn ystod y tymor fel arfer.

#### Aelwyd

Diffinnir aelwyd fel un person sy'n byw ar ei ben ei hun neu grŵp o bobl (nad ydynt o reidrydd yn perthyn i'w gilydd) sy'n byw yn yr un cyfeiriad ac sy'n rhannu cyfleusterau coginio ac ystafell fyw neu loifa neu le bwyta.

Rhaid i aelwyd gynnwys o leiaf un person sy'n byw fel arfer yn y cyfeiriad. Nid yw grŵp o breswylwyr byrdymor sy'n cyd-fyw â'i gilydd na grŵp o bobl mewn cyfeiriad lle mai dim ond ymwelwyr sy'n aros yn cael eu cyfrif fel aelwyd.

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### Definitions

#### Cohabiting couple family

A cohabiting couple family consists of two people of any sex who are living together as a couple, with or without their child(ren), but who are not married or in a same-sex civil partnership. The child(ren) may belong to both members of the couple or only one. Children are included in the family only if they are not themselves living with a spouse, same-sex civil partner or partner and do not have any children of their own in the household.

Cohabiting couples with their grandchild(ren) are also considered a cohabiting couple family if there are no children from the intervening generation present in the household (note that children of the couple may also be present if they are not parents or grandparents of the youngest generation).

#### Cohabiting couple household

A cohabiting couple household is a household that comprises a cohabiting couple family and no other person. This definition is used in most results from the 2011 Census.

In a small number of results a cohabiting couple household is defined as a household that contains at least one cohabiting couple, but does not contain any married or same-sex civil partnership couples. When this definition is used it is clearly indicated.

#### Dependent child

A dependent child is a person aged 0 – 15 in a household (whether or not in a family) or aged 16 – 18 in full-time education and living in a family with his or her parent(s). It does not include any children who have a spouse, partner or child living in the household.

#### Family

A family is defined as a group of people who are either:

- a married, same-sex civil partnership, or cohabiting couple, with or without child(ren)
- a lone parent with child(ren)
- a married, same-sex civil partnership, or cohabiting couple with grandchild(ren) but with no children present from the intervening generation
- a single grandparent with grandchild(ren) but no children present from the intervening generation

Children in couple families need not belong to both members of the couple.

For single or couple grandparents with grandchildren present, the children of the grandparent(s) may also be present if they are not parents or grandparents of the youngest generation present.

#### Full-time student

A full-time student is a person of any age who has indicated that they are a schoolchild or student in full-time education.

Schoolchildren and students in full-time education studying away from their family home are treated as usually resident at their term-time address.

#### Household

A household is defined as one person living alone, or a group of people (not necessarily related) living at the same address who share cooking facilities and share a living room or sitting room or dining area

A household must contain at least one person whose place of usual residence is at the address. A group of short-term residents living together is not classified as a household, and neither is a group of people at an address where only visitors are staying.

#### Household composition

Mae cyfansoddiad aelwydydd yn dosbarthu aelwydydd yn ôl y cydberthnasau rhwng aelodau'r aelwyd. Caiff aelwydydd sy'n cynnwys un teulu a neb arall eu dosbarthu yn ôl y math o deulu (teulu pâr priod, partneriaeth sifil o'r un rhyw neu bâr sy'n cyd-fyw) a nifer y plant dibynnol. Caiff aelwydydd eraill eu dosbarthu yn ôl nifer y bobl, nifer y plant dibynnol neu p'un a yw'r aelwyd ond yn cynnwys myfyrwyr neu bobl 65 oed a throsodd.

Defnyddir y diffiniad hwn yn y rhan fwyaf o ganlyniadau Cyfrifiad 2011. Mewn nifer fach o ganlyniadau caiff dosbarthiad amgen ei ddefnyddio sy'n diffinio aelwydydd yn ôl oedran aelodau'r aelwyd. Nid yw'n ystyried y cydberthnasau rhyngddynt. Mewn ganlyniadau lle defnyddir y diffiniad gwahanol hwn fe'i nodir yn glir.

#### **Teulu un rhiant**

Mae teulu un rhiant yn cynnwys tad neu fam gyda'i blentyn(phlentyn) neu ei blant(phlant) lle nad oes gan y rhiant gymar, partner sifil o'r un rhyw na phartner yn yr aelwyd ac nid oes gan y plentyn(plant) gymar, partner sifil o'r un rhyw na phlentyn yn yr aelwyd. Ystyrir bod neiniau neu deidiau unigol gyda'u hwyron hefyd yn deulu un rhiant os nad oes unrhyw blant yn y genedlaeth yn y canol yn yr aelwyd (noder y gall plant y nain neu'r taid hefyd fod yn bresennol os nad ydynt yn rhieni nac yn neiniau a theidiau'r genhedlaeth ieuengaf).

#### **Cartref un rhiant**

Mae cartref un rhiant yn un sy'n cynnwys teulu un rhiant a neb arall. Caiff y diffiniad hwn ei ddefnyddio yn y rhan fwyaf o ganlyniadau o Gyfrifiad 2011.

Mewn nifer fach o ganlyniadau diffinnir cartref un rhiant fel cartref sy'n cynnwys o leiaf un teulu un rhiant, ond nad yw'n cynnwys unrhyw barau priod, partneriaethau sifil o'r un rhyw na pharau sy'n cyd-fyw. Lle y defnyddir y diffiniad hwn nodir hynny'n glir.

#### **Teulu pâr priod**

Mae teulu pâr priod yn cynnwys gŵr a gwraig sydd â phlant neu heb blant. Gall y plant berthyn i'r ddau ohonynt neu dim ond un. Dim ond os nad ydynt hwy eu hunain yn byw gyda phriod, partner sifil o'r un rhyw neu bartner ac nad oes ganddynt eu plant eu hunain yn byw yn yr aelwyd y caiff plant eu cynnwys yn y teulu.

Ystyrir bod gŵr a gwraig gyda'u hwyron yn deulu pâr priod hefyd os nad oes unrhyw blant yn y genhedlaeth yn y canol yn yr aelwyd (noder y gall plant y pâr hefyd fod yn bresennol os nad ydynt yn rhieni nac yn neiniau a theidiau'r genhedlaeth ieuengaf).

#### **Aelwyd pâr priod**

Mae aelwyd pâr priod yn aelwyd sy'n cynnwys teulu pâr priod a neb arall. Caiff y diffiniad hwn ei ddefnyddio yn y rhan fwyaf o ganlyniadau Cyfrifiad 2011.

Mewn nifer fach o ganlyniadau caiff aelwyd pâr priod ei ddiffinio fel aelwyd sy'n cynnwys un pâr priod o leiaf. Lle y caiff y diffiniad hwn ei ddefnyddio fe'i nodir yn glir.

#### **Un teulu a neb arall (Un teulu'n unig)**

Mae aelwyd yn cynnwys 'un teulu a neb arall' os mai dim ond un teulu sydd yn yr aelwyd ac nid oes unrhyw un arall nad yw'n aelod o'r teulu (unigolion heb eu grwpio).

#### **Teulu pâr partneriaeth sifil o'r un rhyw**

Mae teulu pâr partneriaeth sifil o'r un rhyw yn cynnwys dau bartner sifil o'r un rhyw sydd â phlant neu heb blant. Gall y plant berthyn i'r naill aelod o'r pâr neu'r llall. Dim ond os nad ydynt hwy eu hunain yn byw gyda phriod, partner sifil o'r un rhyw neu bartner ac nad oes ganddynt unrhyw blant eu hunain yn yr aelwyd y caiff plant eu cynnwys.

Caiff partneriaid sifil o'r un rhyw gyda'u hwyron eu hystyried yn deulu partneriaeth sifil o'r un rhyw hefyd os nad oes unrhyw blant yn y genhedlaeth yn y canol yn yr aelwyd (noder y gall plant y pâr hefyd fod yn bresennol os nad ydynt yn rhieni nac yn neiniau a theidiau i'r genhedlaeth ieuengaf).

#### **Aelwyd pâr partneriaeth sifil o'r un rhyw**

Mae aelwyd pâr partneriaeth sifil o'r un rhyw yn aelwyd sy'n cynnwys teulu pâr partneriaeth sifil o'r un rhyw a neb arall. Caiff y diffiniad hwn ei ddefnyddio yn y rhan fwyaf o ganlyniadau o Gyfrifiad 2011.

Mewn nifer fach o ganlyniadau caiff aelwyd pâr partneriaeth sifil o'r un rhyw ei ddiffinio fel aelwyd sy'n cynnwys un pâr partneriaeth sifil o'r un rhyw o leiaf a dim parau priod. Lle defnyddir y diffiniad hwn fe'i nodir yn glir.

#### **Preswlydd arferol**

Y brif sylfaen boblogaeth ar gyfer allbynnau Cyfrifiad 2011 yw'r boblogaeth breswlydd arferol ar ddiwrnod y cyfrifiad, 27 Mawrth 2011. Er bod y boblogaeth a gyfrifwyd yn cynnwys preswlywyr byrdymor nad ydynt yn dod o'r DU, caiff y boblogaeth hon ei dadansoddi ar wahân ac nid yw wedi'i chynnwys ym mhrif allbynnau Cyfrifiad 2011. Caiff yr holl allbynnau, oni nodir yn wahanol, eu cynhyrchu gan ddefnyddio preswlywyr arferol yn y DU yn unig.

At ddbenion Cyfrifiad 2011, mae preswlydd arferol y DU yn cynnwys unrhyw un a oedd, ar ddiwrnod y cyfrifiad, yn y DU ac wedi aros neu'n bwriadu aros yn y DU am gyfnod o 12 mis neu fwy, neu â chyfeiriad parhaol yn y DU a'r tu allan i'r DU ac yn bwriadu aros y tu allan i'r DU am lai na 12 mis.

Household composition classifies households according to the relationships between the household members. Households consisting of one family and no other people are classified according to the type of family (married, same-sex civil partnership or cohabiting couple family, or lone parent family) and the number of dependent children. Other households are classified by the number people, the number of dependent children, or whether the household consists only of students or only of people aged 65 and over.

This definition is used in most results from the 2011 Census. In a small number of results an alternative classification is used that defines households by the age of the household members. It takes no account of the relationships between them. In results where this different definition is used it is clearly indicated.

#### **Lone parent family**

A lone parent family consists of a father or mother with his or her child(ren) where the parent does not have a spouse, same-sex civil partner or partner in the household and the child(ren) do not have a spouse, same-sex civil partner or child in the household. A lone grandparent with his or her grandchild(ren) are also considered a lone parent family if there are no children in the intervening generation present in the household (note that children of the grandparent may also be present if they are not parents or grandparents of the youngest generation).

#### **Lone parent household**

A lone parent household is a household that comprises a lone parent family and no other person. This definition is used in most results from the 2011 Census.

In a small number of results a lone parent household is defined as a household that contains at least one lone parent family, but does not contain any married, same-sex civil partnership or cohabiting couples. When this definition is used it is clearly indicated.

#### **Married couple household**

A married couple family consists of a husband and wife with or without child(ren). The child(ren) may belong to both members of the couple or only one. Children are included in the family only if they are not themselves living with a spouse, same-sex civil partner or partner and do not have any children of their own in the household.

A husband and wife with their grandchild(ren) are also considered a married couple family if there are no children in the intervening generation present in the household (note that children of the couple may also be present if they are not parents or grandparents of the youngest generation).

#### **Married couple household**

A married couple household is a household that comprises a married couple family and no other person. This definition is used in most results from the 2011 Census.

In a small number of results a married couple household is defined as a household that contains at least one married couple. When this definition is used it is clearly indicated.

#### **One family and no others (One family only)**

A household consists of 'one family and no others' if there is only one family in the household and there are no non-family people (ungrouped individuals).

#### **Same-sex civil partnership couple family**

A same-sex civil partnership couple family consists of two same-sex civil partners with or without child(ren). The child(ren) may belong to either member of the couple. Children are included in the family only if they are not themselves living with a spouse, same-sex civil partner or partner and do not have any children of their own in the household.

Same-sex civil partners with their grandchild(ren) are also considered a same-sex civil partnership family if there are no children in the intervening generation present in the household (note that children of the couple may also be present if they are not parents or grandparents of the youngest generation).

#### **Same-sex civil partnership couple household**

A same-sex civil partnership couple household is a household that comprises a same-sex civil partnership couple family and no other person. This definition is used in most results from the 2011 Census.

In a small number of results a same-sex civil partnership couple household is defined as a household that contains at least one same-sex civil partnership couple and no married couples. When this definition is used it is clearly indicated.

#### **Usual resident**

The main population base for outputs from the 2011 Census is the usual resident population as at census day 27 March 2011. Although the population base for enumeration included non-UK short-term residents, this population is analysed separately and is not included in the main outputs from the 2011 Census. All outputs, unless specified, are produced using only usual residents of the UK.

For 2011 Census purposes, a usual resident of the UK is anyone who, on census day, was in the UK and had stayed or intended to stay in the UK for a period of 12 months or more, or had a permanent UK address and was outside the UK and intended to be outside the UK for less than 12 months.
