As a result of all the information which is shown on the Proposal and Constraint Maps, further consideration needs to be given to the way in which information is presented, specifically with regard to the paper version of the Plan. The Councils will arrange for the Maps of the Plan area to be further subdivided into sub-areas ensuring that the information presented is more visible and that the scale of the Plan is more detailed. Further, the appearance of the layers i.e. colour and style will be refined. This will ensure that the final version of the Plan is clear and easy to read.
