The Plastic Island crew are busy preparing a resource pack for schools.


We will be visiting schools with a presentation to raise awareness.


Cwmni Cread working with young carers to create a documentary about their lives.


Identity cards now in the hands of young carers, and going from strength to strength.

Young Carers Identity Cards






The cards are now going from strength to strength and we want to focus next on getting discounts for the individuals to receive when using the card.
