

Services available through the library

Every library in Gwynedd has a collection of books about caring; some of them are written by carers. There is also free access to computers and the internet at libraries – there are many forums online that are specific for carers, which you may find useful. Wi-fi is also available in every library.

We are not charging fines at all on any books which are returned late.

When you borrow a book you will have 12 weeks from the return date to bring your books back to the library. After the 12 weeks, you will be responsible for the full cost of replacing the book. But if we receive the book back from you at any time – there will be no fine and no cost!

Home Library

Gwynedd Library Service can offer a library service direct to your home, in certain circumstances, if:

- you suffer from mobility problems
- you cannot carry items
- you suffer long-term illness
- you live far away from a library service point (building or mobile)

or

- **you look after someone full-time**

They offer a selection of books, audio books on CD in English and Welsh and Large Print Books – in Welsh and English. This is a friendly and convenient monthly service - which is free.
