What's Happened?



 New Rules governing the privacy and Security of Personal Data

Power to individuals over how their data is processed and used

Need to report on all high risk incidents



Principles



- > Fair and legal use
- ➤ Not be used for another purpose
- > Adequate, relevant and not be excessive
- Correct and up-dated
- > Avoid excessive retention
- > Individuals entitled to see their information
- > Information should be secure



Tighten up on current rules



When data is being gathered, the individual must be notified:-

- Who
- Purpose
- Legal basis
- Share
- Retention period
- Individuals rights



A Governor is someone who:-
