### **COVID-19: Alert Level 0 measures strengthened**

The Welsh Government confirmed on 29 October 2021 that Wales will remain at Alert Level 0, but warned that the situation is serious due to a sharp rise in coronavirus cases and some extra measures have been announced in response. To read the latest statement go to:

### **COVID-19: New self-isolation requirements**

Adults who are fully vaccinated and children and young people aged 5 to 17 will now be asked to self-isolate until they have received a negative PCR test if someone in their household has symptoms, or tests positive, for COVID-19. For the updated guidance, go to:
