TAX: Retail, Leisure and Hospitality Rates Relief 2022/23

This relief is available for the 2022/23 tax year to businesses in the retail, leisure and hospitality sectors and in addition to the Small Business Rate Relief. The scheme can offer eligible businesses a 50% discount of up to £110,000 – completing a simple application form is required, which is available here:

HMRC have issued guidance on preparing for the Health and Social Care Levy – including a new message to be included on

pay slips. The Levy will increase National Insurance contributions for most employees by 1.25% from 6 April 2022. The guidance is available at:
