TAX: Making Tax Digital for VAT

From 1 November 2022, you will not be able to use your existing VAT online account to send quarterly or monthly VAT Returns, and will need to sign up for Making Tax Digital for VAT (MTD) and use compatible software to keep your VAT records and file your VAT Returns. For more information, go to:
