### **Pub is the Hub – community grants**

Grants of up to £3,000 are available to enable rural pub owners, licensees, and local communities to work together to help support and sustain local services in England, Scotland and Wales. Pub is the Hub's Community Services Fund will assist projects which support the needs of local communities by using pubs to offer a new service or replace a service that has already been lost, such as a local shop, library, post office or community centre, or encouraging the local sourcing of products, providing school meals, IT training and church services. ### **Residential Outdoor Education Sector Fund**

The Welsh Government has established a fund to support the residential outdoor education sector in Wales with an initial allocation of £2m. This fund will provide eligible centres across Wales with support to cover essential operating costs during the period June to September 2021. The fund will have a capped maximum grant of £45k per successful applicant. Formal applications for funding are likely to be invited early in June 2021, with a 3-week deadline for completion. In order to gauge the likely eligibility and take up of the fund, the Welsh Government are requesting that those organisations that may be eligible for support and who wish to apply, complete a short expression of interest form. ## **Cei Llechi Caernarfon: Units available**

Work on the regeneration of Cei Llechi Caernarfon is drawing to a close and there are work/retail units available to let. Tying the old and the new, modern-day Cei Llechi will offer a place to create, experience and buy and sell. The Caernarfon based social enterprise, Galeri Caernarfon Cyf are responsible for managing and running the site on behalf of Caernarfon Harbour Trust.

The “new” Cei Llechi will provide a space for makers to design/build and sell their products, bringing manufacturing (albeit on a smaller scale to the olden days) back to this important area of the town.

Within Cei Llechi, there are 19 work/retail units, interpretation area outlining the history and importance of Cei Llechi, a meeting room and 3 self-catering holiday lets. The project to re-develop Cei Llechi has been made possible with financial support from the National Lottery Heritage Fund, Cadw, Welsh Government, Gwynedd Council and Caernarfon Harbour Trust.
