COVID-19: Coronavirus regulations to end in Wales

Following the outcome of the 3-weekly review of coronavirus regulations, the Welsh Government has announced that the last remaining coronavirus protections in law will come to an end next Monday, 30 May 2022. It will no longer be a legal requirement to wear a face covering in health and care settings but it is strongly recommended to do so, to help protect the most vulnerable and staff working in these settings.
