COVID-19: New regulations on face coverings introduced

From today (28 February 2022) people will no longer be legally required to wear face coverings in a range of indoor places, including cinemas, theatres, community centres, museums and gyms. Face coverings continue to be a legal requirement for adults and children aged 11 and over, unless exempt, in shops, hairdressing and beauty businesses, on public transport and in health and care settings. REGULATIONS: Smoke-free law changes from 1 March 2022

From 1 March 2022, all types of self-contained accommodation, including cottages, caravans, holiday cabins and any other short-term letting accommodation, and all hotels, guest houses, pubs etc. will be required to be smoke-free at all times. After this date, it will be an offence to smoke in any area within these premises, and a fine could be imposed. More information is available at:
